
## WHAT IS AN IMPLANT OVERDENTURE?

An Overdenture is a denture which has some attachments inside that snaps on top of the implants.



Regular dentures fit on top of patient's gums. But when a patient doesn't have enough height and width of bone, patient struggles to keep the denture in place. This is extremely common in lower jaw. Having at least two implants for lower and four implants for upper helps us to make an overdenture which stays very secure in patient's mouth.

When we make an overdenture for upper we can remove the palate more than half and it doesn't have to extend all the way back in the palate. This greatly improves patient's comfort.
